

In Sickness and in Health in South Texas – Narrative Submission Guidelines

UIW Libraries welcome your narratives and encourage your questions. We ask that you submit narratives with a general audience in mind. We reserve the right to accept or not accept submissions if they fall outside of the project objectives or are not in alignment with the UIW Mission. Narratives will be hosted on the UIW Libraries Athenaeum after the initial stage of submission.

- Because we require that submissions be open, librarians will help with the selection of an appropriate [Creative Commons License](#). What this means is that submissions can be openly used by others for purposes of interest, scholarship, and research. This may result in publication. To meet the objectives of sharing information and having information used freely, a license of CC BY (which translates to open access and give me credit for my work) may be adequate. If you are interested in ensuring that your work is shared in a like manner as you are sharing, then you would use CC BY SA (share alike). If you want to make sure that your submission is not used in a commercial production or publication, then you would add NC. CC BY SA NC. Click the link to Creative Commons Licensing for more information. The default license will be CC BY but the selection can be changed during your submission process. - Must be 18 years or older to submit a narrative and agree to the guidelines for submission.
- We have created some subjects that may describe your submission. Please select all that you feel are appropriate for your submission. If we did not provide a subject that describes your submission, you have an opportunity to provide your own.
- We realize that COVID has been a traumatic experience and that reading narratives and writing narratives may cause unease. Please find organizational information for counseling assistance on the *In Sickness and in Health in South Texas LibGuide*.

We look forward to sharing your experiences and learning from our community. We hope that you will participate in the symposium – *In Sickness and in Health in South Texas*, which will be hosted on the UIW Broadway Campus in October 2022.
